This is a new enterprise by the Cathedral Education Officer to help schools who, for reasons of cost or distance or curriculum constraints, are unable to bring their pupils on a visit to Ely Cathedral.

The object is to offer a half- day learning experience in your own school which gives a flavour of what a visit to the site would provide and might encourage the children to bring their parents on a visit to the building itself.

The experience is in two parts:

- ❖ A guided tour of the Cathedral using a Powerpoint presentation.
- ❖ A carousel of activities which enable pupils to explore different aspects of the Cathedral's life and history.

Schools can choose from the following activities, each of which would last about 30 minutes.

- The Cathedral building and special places
- The story of St Etheldreda
- The life of a Benedictine monk
- Pilgrimage
- People in the Cathedral

### THE SCHOOL WILL NEED TO PROVIDE PLEASE:

- ✓ Screen and stand for Powerpoint presentation
- ✓ An adult helper to supervise each group activity
- ✓ Appropriate tables and chairs for activities chosen
- ✓ Paper, pencils, scissors etc where necessary

The cost is £50 plus travelling expenses.
